On Thursday Evening, March 16, 2017, the monthly meeting of the Mauldin Civitan Club included an informative presentation highlighting **Family Footprint**, an organization seeking to empower, improve and advance the family through an updated employer validated program. The speaker for the evening was *Ms. Natalie Milom*, staff member, who explained the goals, mission and purpose of the program, which is funded in part by the United States Department of Labor.

There are three components of the FAMILY FOOTPRINT Program:

- The Advanced Manufacturing Program which is designed for parents interested in an advanced manufacturing career. The program incorporates advanced-level training, certifications in specified areas of manufacturing, PAID work experience and employment placement assistance.
 Upon completion of the program, the goal is for participants and their families to benefit from a positive, comfortable and secure lifestyle change.
- The Children's Enrichment Center focuses on quality early child care for children ages six (6) weeks to age five (5). The essence of the program is in the areas of cognition, language development, creativity and other skills needed to prepare children for successful transition to school.
- The afterschool program emphasizes academic skills, social-emotional learning, STEAM, tutoring and other skills which will enhance the holistic development of each child. The program accepts children up to age thirteen (13).

The presentation concluded with a question and answer period. All information was well received by Civitan members in attendance.
