The Mauldin Civitan Club's first speaker for 2019 was Ms. Rhetta Jones, Campus Director of Marie Younts Girls' Home located in Mauldin SC, on January 17, 2019.

The home provides residential care for up to six girls. It is a satellite location of the Connie Maxwell Children's Home in Greenwood, SC. According to Ms. Jones, in 1979 the Connie Maxwell Children's Home opened the satellite location on Earle Street in Greenville, SC. In 1996, the Earle Street home for

Girls relocated to Mauldin, SC and was renamed the Marie Younts Girls' Home. Their mission is to care for children while developing and strengthening positive relationships in a Christian environment.

Ms. Jones told the success story of a young woman's journey at the home from high school to college and presently as a Captain in the military service.

The information was well received. The Mauldin Civitan Club was invited to tour the home to see its impact on the lives of the girls.
