Gary Finley, Civitan International South Carolina District Governor, was the speaker at the Mauldin Civitan Club, August 1, 2019.

A new member was just installed and two other individuals expressed their desire to become members prior to Gary speaking to the club. Gary emphasized the importance of recruiting and retaining members as an ongoing initiative of Civitan clubs. Clubs

have to devise innovative ways to increase memberships as well as retain members. Social media such as Facebook was an example given as an excellent method to disseminate information in the community about Civitan and the positive activities Civitan is doing in the community.

Gary mentioned that the basket, at the Civitan International Convention held July 3-6, 2019 in Greenville SC, from the Mauldin Civitan Club was one of the best baskets if not the best. Mauldin Civitan Club member, Alannah Suzi Knebusch, designed the magnificent basket.

Gary Finley advised that there has been a significant decline in the candy box funds. 75 percent of the proceeds from the candy boxes go to the Civitan International Research Center and the remaining 25 percent stays with the club. Some of the decline is due to the fact that people usually pay by card or phones in places of business. Since fewer people play by cash, no change is being placed in the candy boxes. This is an area too that needs revitalization.

Gary expressed that for the Mauldin Civitan Club only being in its third year, it has covered a lot of areas; it will continue to be an asset to the community and Civitan International organization.
