We will bring a new slate of officers to you in April. I hope you will consider taking a leadership position. If we are going to remain a productive club, we will need each of you to step up to the plate.

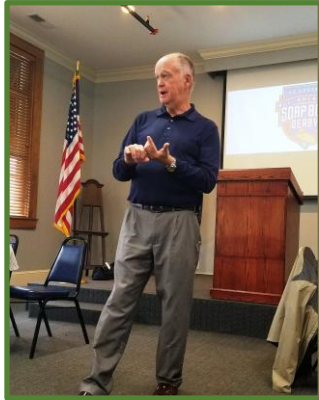

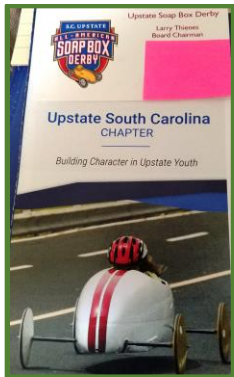
