# Update From Mayor Merritt February 5, 2021

Dear Concerned Citizens of Mauldin:

I wanted to reach out to you to provide an update on our progress with the City Council approved Resolution No. 6-2020 to..." develop guidelines for education and training opportunities for diversity training and the use of social media for all elected officials, city employees and persons serving on city boards, commissions, and other capacities for the city and also providing for public forums for citizens and local business to engage in discussions of diversity issues and provide recommendations for city officials". This letter serves as an update on our City's efforts regarding the Resolution.

Develop Guidelines for Education and Training Opportunities for Diversity Training and the use of Social Media for All Elected Officials, City Employees and Persons Serving on City Boards, Commissions, and Other Capacities for the City

- Civility, diversity, and inclusion training for all Department Heads and Supervisor level employees was conducted by Eli Corporation out of Atlanta and Greenville Technical College's Office of Economic Development and Corporate Training on October 29, 2020.
- During November and December 2020, all hourly City employees took part in a computer-based training on Civil Treatment and Harassment.

- Future Training on Social Media has been developed for all City employees, This training will be delivered to all employees in April 2021.
- City Council has engaged Sharp Brain Consulting to conduct diversity and inclusion training for all elected officials. Our initial council session was conducted on December 11, 2020. In addition to diversity and inclusion training, the firm will be tasked with providing training related to the use of social media.
- We as a Council are in Day 6 of our 21 Day Challenge. Our next scheduled debriefing session with Sharp Brain Consulting will be later in February.

#### BYLAWS AND ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION PROPOSAL

This is important information from an article by Past International President Patricia Ann Perkal in January on Facebook:

Over the past year and a half, the Civitan International Board of Directors journeyed through the revision of the organization's outdated Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. These governance documents were rewritten in 2004 and have had ten amendments over the years. The board appointed a Governance Documents Committee made up of Past International Presidents and Past International Directors. The committee along with legal counsel determined the need for a rewritten version rather than multiple amendments. The board and committee both reviewed past and current membership reports, club building statistics, leadership recruitment limitations and membership surveys. The committee provided recommendations to the board throughout the past year and presented a final draft of the new governance documents in November 2020. The board approved those documents. The Articles and Bylaws will now be presented to the membership and will be voted upon at this year's Civitan International Convention. The Articles require a positive two-thirds vote and the Bylaws require a majority vote (over 50%).
