

INSIGHTS FROM CIVITAN INTERNATIONAL REGION TWO DIRECTOR



Bill Tolleson, Civitan International Director Region Two, was the guest speaker at the Mauldin Civitan zoom meeting, November 18, 2021.

Bill Tolleson has held numerous positions within Civitan International, has a

wealth of institutional knowledge of Civitan International and shared some of that information with the Mauldin Civitan Club.

Bill Tolleson expressed many insights about Civitan but particularly what stood out was while recruiting and talking to others about Civitan, you need to develop your "elevator speech". Basically, it is s short description of Civitan International that any listener can understand it in a short period of time. The description typically explains who it is for, what it does, why it is needed and how it will get done. The member who can share with others how membership in Civitan has personally impacted his or her life is the best recruiting tool there is.

A lady contacted me on our FB page because she saw we were at the Judson YMCA and she needed food. I took her 5 grocery bags full from my sister church's food pantry. Her name is Lynn Rackley and below is her testimony.

"I just want to share with this group and thank everyone for the work you do. Last week I seen a post about helping those in need and I reached out because my family is in need at this time. And a quick respond back. (Ms. Suzi Knebusch) met me today with so many needed things. I know The LORD sent her. As we met and talked I noticed a Civitan Shirt she was wearing and then such sweet memories of just the word Civitan flooded my heart. Because in 1963 I gave my 8 year old heart to "Jesus" at Civitan Fresh Air Camp in Cleveland SC where I attended Camp for 4 summers in a row. This sweet lady has no clue the Blessing she gave me today not just material but Spiritually. My family has been living on the promises of God daily for 9 years. Dec.8th, My husband took a flu Vaccine and it shut his brain down. 13 months in ICU on a ventilator, 1 month on the floor and 3 months in a nursing home and then back to the hospital another 3 months. He had lost all body functions but slowly gained limited things back and this summer a battle of heart attacks, 3 open heart surgeries, 2 sets of stints after then, and a pacemaker, defibrillator and a experimental thing added called ribbions. We were living good for a few months then July 23 our 49th Anniversary another attack. Dr. said bring your kids in and Lets talk. They all came and he began to explain how his heart was past fixing-- that he could keep him in the hospital and give him only fluids or I could bring him home. Home of course was our choice. He still told us to begin to prepare for us losing him. Of course I never even thought of it. Dr. patted me on the shoulder and said I know you didn't want to hear this but I have been his doctor 12 years and these last 9 Years time to time I knew it was over. I have seen so much trauma and he is certainly favored by the LORD. Last week we did a televisit after 4 months and we all cried. He seen him sitting up in his mobile chair and said PTL! I hope The Lord will protect me as he is you...We have a 26 year old grandson living with us who has been diagnosed with early Parkinson Disease and has done Chemo and Radiation also a 15 year Granddaughter we have because my daughter is blind and We felt she needed more than our daughter could do. Anyway sorry for the long Praise but I feel GOD has came full circle today giving me that extra something my soul needed. We aren't eligible for any Government Assistance because we owned our house, which our son does now because we couldn't pay the property taxes and up keep. I think in 3 years we can. But I reached out because my family was in need. I have never done this but when it comes to your family you do what you can. My story

goes on.. Lol. Sitting typing and praising my LORD for all we got today. And again that special Assurance My GOD sent this sweet lady to give me short conversation and sweet memories of Civitan camp.

Thank you to each one. May you all have A Healthy, Happy Merry Christmas...."
