Mauldin Planning Commission and Building Codes departments approved a zoning change within the BridgeWay Station planned development to allow a 152-unit housing complex aimed at senior living. The four-story building proposed by Buvermo Investments would consist of market rate apartments for seniors 55 and older. Access would be from internal corridors and there would be 167 parking spaces, including garage space.
